## Thy Kingdom Come

**Luke 17:20–21** (ESV): Being asked by the Pharisees when the kingdom of God would come, [Jesus] answered them, "The kingdom of God is not coming in ways that can be observed, nor will they say, 'Look, here it is!' or 'There!' for behold, the kingdom of God is in the midst of you."

Our Lord teaches us to pray "Thy Kingdom Come." Luther reminds us in the Small Catechism that "The kingdom of God certainly comes by itself without our prayer, but we pray in this petition that it may come to us also." This is what our Lord is telling us in the verses above, too.

As we read the Bible we find that "God's kingdom" can mean different things in different contexts. Christians have traditionally distinguished His "kingdom of power," "kingdom of grace," and "kingdom of glory." So for example, when we gaze at the night sky filled with stars, we marvel at how "The heavens declare the glory of God" (Psalm 19). Nature proclaims God's glory, power and presence for anyone who has eyes to see and whose heart is not too hardened with sinful cynicism to acknowledge it. But of course the "kingdom of power" has to do not only with beauty in nature but also with judgment. Ours is a fallen and sin-filled world, often exhibiting both the stubborn rejection of God's rule and it's consequences: disease and disaster, violence and injustice, and ultimately: death – the "wages of sin." All this is abundantly apparent in God's kingdom of power.

But there is also His "kingdom of grace" – His gracious rule in the hearts of all who have become His people through faith in Jesus Christ, the Savior. The "kingdom of grace" comes to us when we believe the Gospel, proclaim it, and live according to it. This is what our Lord urges us to pray for in the Lord's Prayer – God's reign and rule in our hearts by faith in Jesus: "Thy kingdom come!" Here, as Luther says, we pray that it may come to us also as Jesus promises: "For behold, the kingdom of God is in the midst of you."

The final kingdom, His "kingdom of glory," refers to God's heavenly kingdom that we long for and pray for, and that will be revealed when Christ Jesus comes again in glory. There, as Psalm 23 says, "I shall dwell in the house of the Lord, forever." And as Jesus promised in John 14:1–3: "In my Father's house are many rooms. ... And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and will take you to myself, that where I am you may be also."

Thus, our faith in Jesus – being a citizen of God's "kingdom of grace" now, guarantees that one day we will live forever with Him in His "kingdom of glory" which will have no end – and in which our lives and our perfect joy will have no end!
